
On 20 May 2016 Vernisher presented an ikebana demonstration for the Women's Fellowship at her Church. At left is a photo of her with her arrangements.


> impressed with it and wanted to find out more about Sogetsu Ikebana.

On behalf of the members who attended the recent workshops I'd like to thank the committee for organising the opportunity for members to take part in such an inspiring and stimulating workshop.


Emily began by demonstrating a series of self-taught techniques, which could be used as mechanics to overcome some of the problems we encounter when working with unusual containers and challenging materials.
